Criteria to compete at various levels	
Level 0	· At the discretion of each Affiliate
Level 1	· At the discretion of each Affiliate
Level 2/SA NAG (Novice Section)	· At the discretion of each Affiliate. An athlete may compete in the SA NAG Novice section for a maximum of 2 years.
SA NAG (Age groups Section)	· An athlete must have competed in the Novice Section at SA National Age Groups Championships (NAG) in order to compete in the Age group section at NAG.
SA Level 3	· An athlete must have competed at NAG in the Age Groups section in order to compete at SA Level 3. A minimum required score of 45 in the figures event of a minimum average execution scores of 45 (adjusting the DD of each element to 1 and removing acros) in a solo or duet routine.
SA Nationals	· An athlete must have competed at SA Level 3 in order to compete at SA Nationals. If an Affiliate feels that an athlete is strong enough to bypass SA Level 3, the Affiliate can apply in writing to the TASC motivating the athletes ability to progress directly to SA Nationals. In order for an Affiliate to make an application, the athlete must have competed at NAG in the Age Groups section or a SSA recognised competition using the National judges in the same season and achieved a minimum average execution score of 50 in the figures event of a minimum average execution scores of 50 (adjusting the DD of each element to 1 and removing acros) for a solo or duet routine. Applications to TASC must be in no later than 1 month prior to the start date of SA Nationals.
